## **What is it?**

United Liberia Press is a service providing instant content management by Liberian community, news, and media organizations. It allows reporters and editors to create and publish articles and images on their organization's website with no technical knowledge, from any computer in the world. Once the site is set up, no technical intervention is necessary at all: changes to the site's content (articles, images, opinions and editorials, announcements, and advertisements) are accomplished via a simple interface over the Internet.

The service is intended to facilitate effective communication and free, open access to independent and accurate media content. By removing the technical burden, we aim to improve intellectual, political, and social discourse in the Liberian diaspora.

## **Benefits**

- The system is based on the Internet and can be used from any computer in the world;
- The system is secure: we use the latest technology to keep your information safe;
- The entire system requires no knowledge of HTML, web programming, or technical knowledge;
- Reporters have a very easy-to-use way to write articles and send them to editors of the organization's website;
- Editors of the organization can review articles, send comments to reporters, and approve articles for publication;
- The approved articles instantly appear on the organization's website;
- The administrators of the organization's site have no work to do – the article is automatically published.

## **How it Works**

1. The organization's web site is set up to connect with United Liberia Press; The process is *very* simple.
2. A reporter logs in to the system over the Internet and writes their article using a system that works just like a common word processor. They can then insert pictures into to their article.
3. An email is send to editors informing them that a new article has been submitted for publication.
4. The editors can review the article and images to make changes. If they want, they can send the article back to the reporter with notes on changes that need to be made. When they are happy with the article and the images, they click one button to publish the article and images.
5. The article instantly appears on the organization's web page.
